

County-wide millage will decrease by 0.15 mill in 2019


County-wide Millage = 122.23




County-wide taxes are determined by both:


Context & Background

- The County was cut again by the MS Department of Corrections in Spring 2018. The Jail is down approx.
 100 State inmates. This is a significant loss of revenue.
- The Board was forced to transfer \$76,657.00 to cover jail costs through the month of August.
- The warden reports the jail could pick up more State inmates by October/November to provide some funding pressure relief.
- The Jail's finances were a major funding concern and issue throughout the budget process.



General Fund


- Sheriff Dept. equals 10.5 mills or 9% County-wide millage
- FY 2019-\$1,490,000
- \$224,000 increase from FY 2017 retained in FY 2019
- This doesn't include County Jail funds
