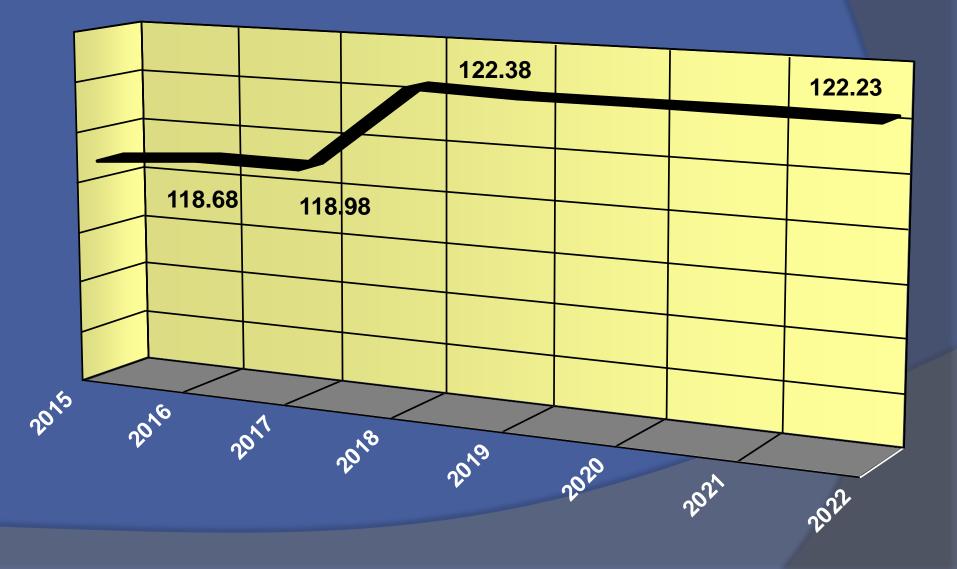

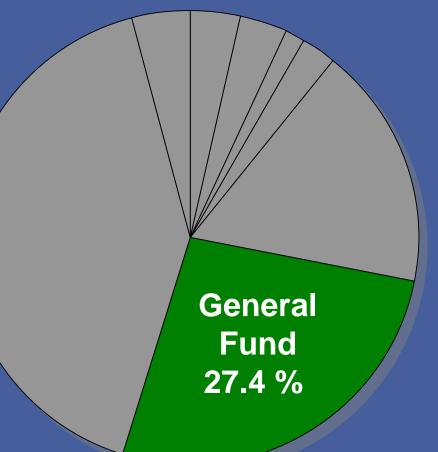
School Dist. 40.6% • Approx. 41% of mills go to Dist. in 2022

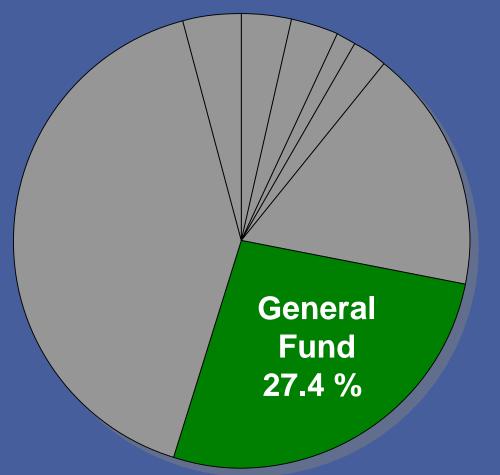


Board *increased* funding by 2.7 percent to provide:

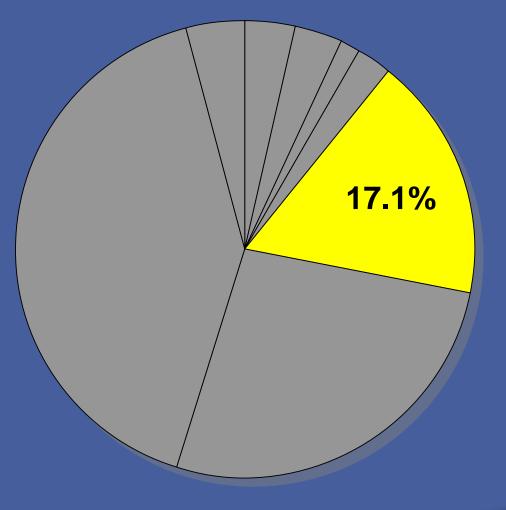
- All full time employees get a pay raise in 2022. No pay raises in 2020 or 2021.

 Increased Sheriff budget for a new full time patrol deputy position.

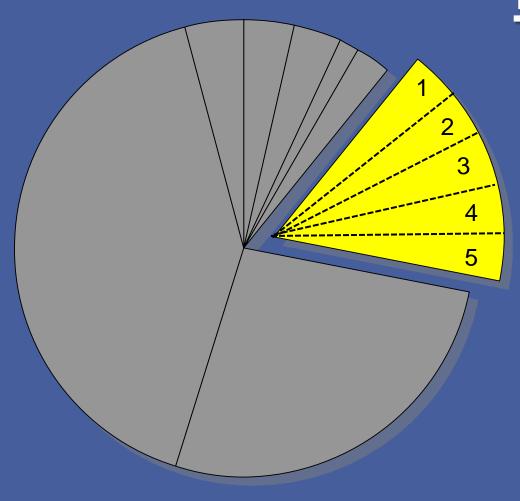

Road & Bridge

- Millage will remain at 20.9 mills in 2022.
- The Board has held this millage rate at 20.9 for 4 years.
- State bridge and road grants supplement County road funds. Grant revenue is not reflected in millage.



Road & Bridge

- The 20.9 mills is then divided evenly between all five districts
- Each district road fund will receive 4.18 mills for the fourth straight year.

Road & Bridge have dropped from 26.70 mills to 20.9 mills over the past decade.

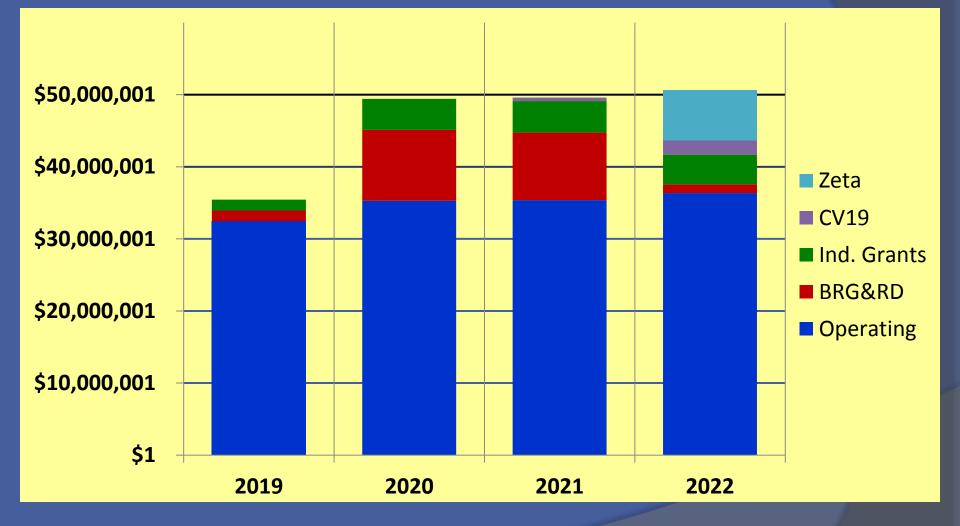
Final Category

- These 5 slices make up 15% of the millage. No change from 2021.
- The "Other" Category is 1 mill or less:
 - Lucedale Library
 - Reappraisal
 - Mandatory Fund
 - Pat Harrison Water Dist.

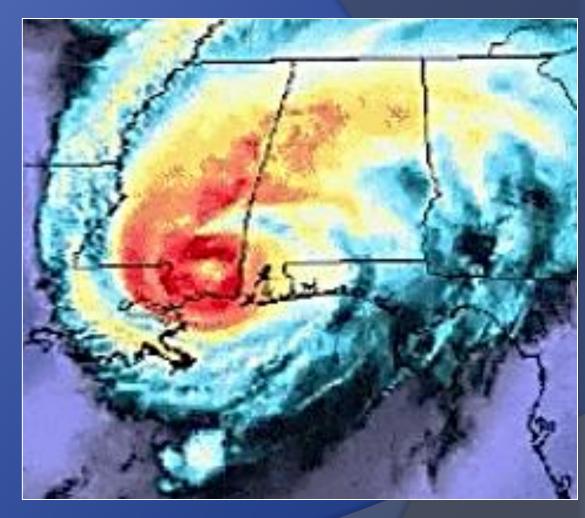
County Total Budget



Increased \$15 Million from FY 2019 to FY 2022

Hurricane Zeta Estimated Costs

\$8.5 Million: - Debris pick-up - Bldg. repairs - Road repairs - Courthouse - Equipment - Labor



Funding Formula: FEMA 75% + MEMA 12.5%= County 12.5%
