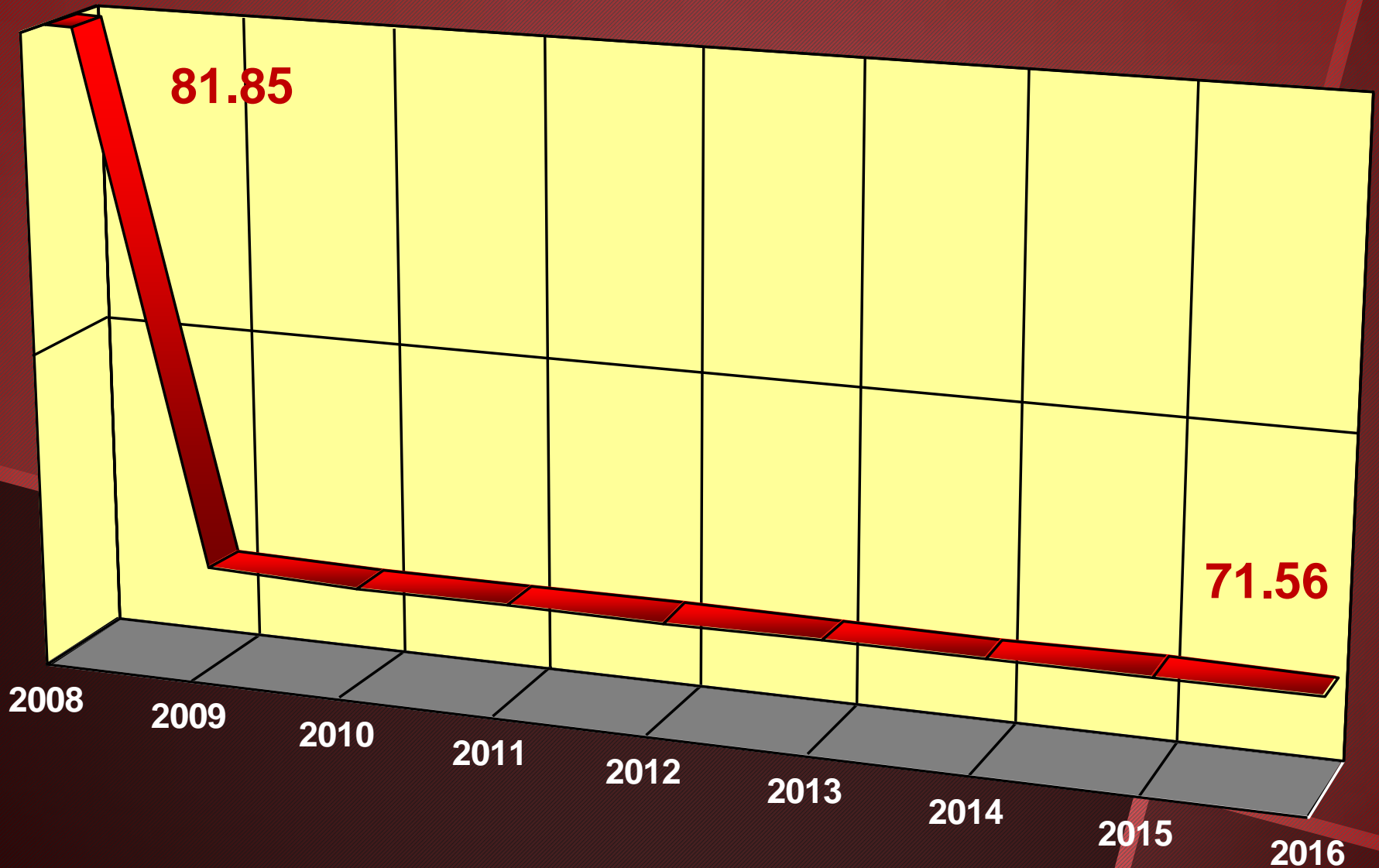
Board Millage

Millage rate over past decade

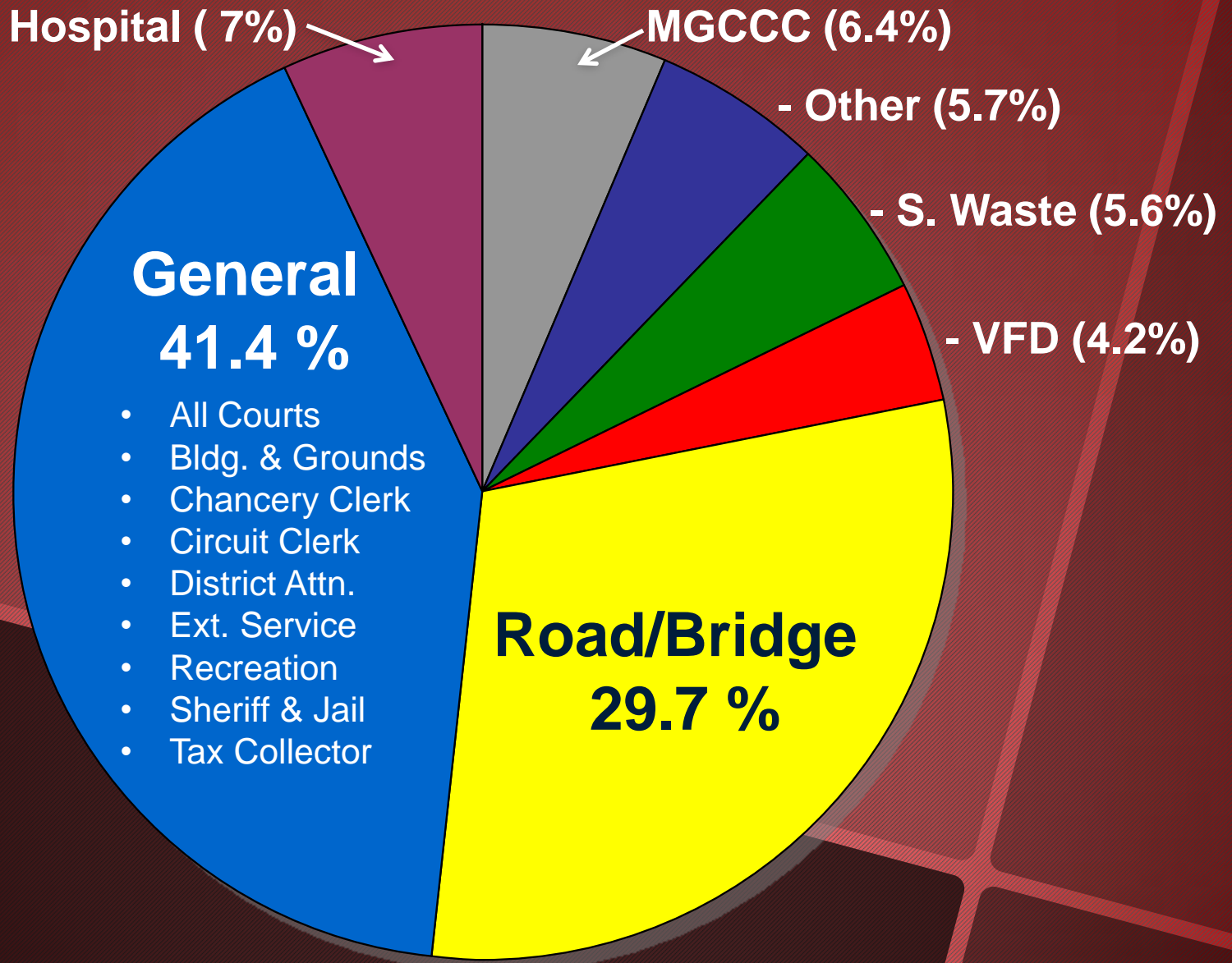

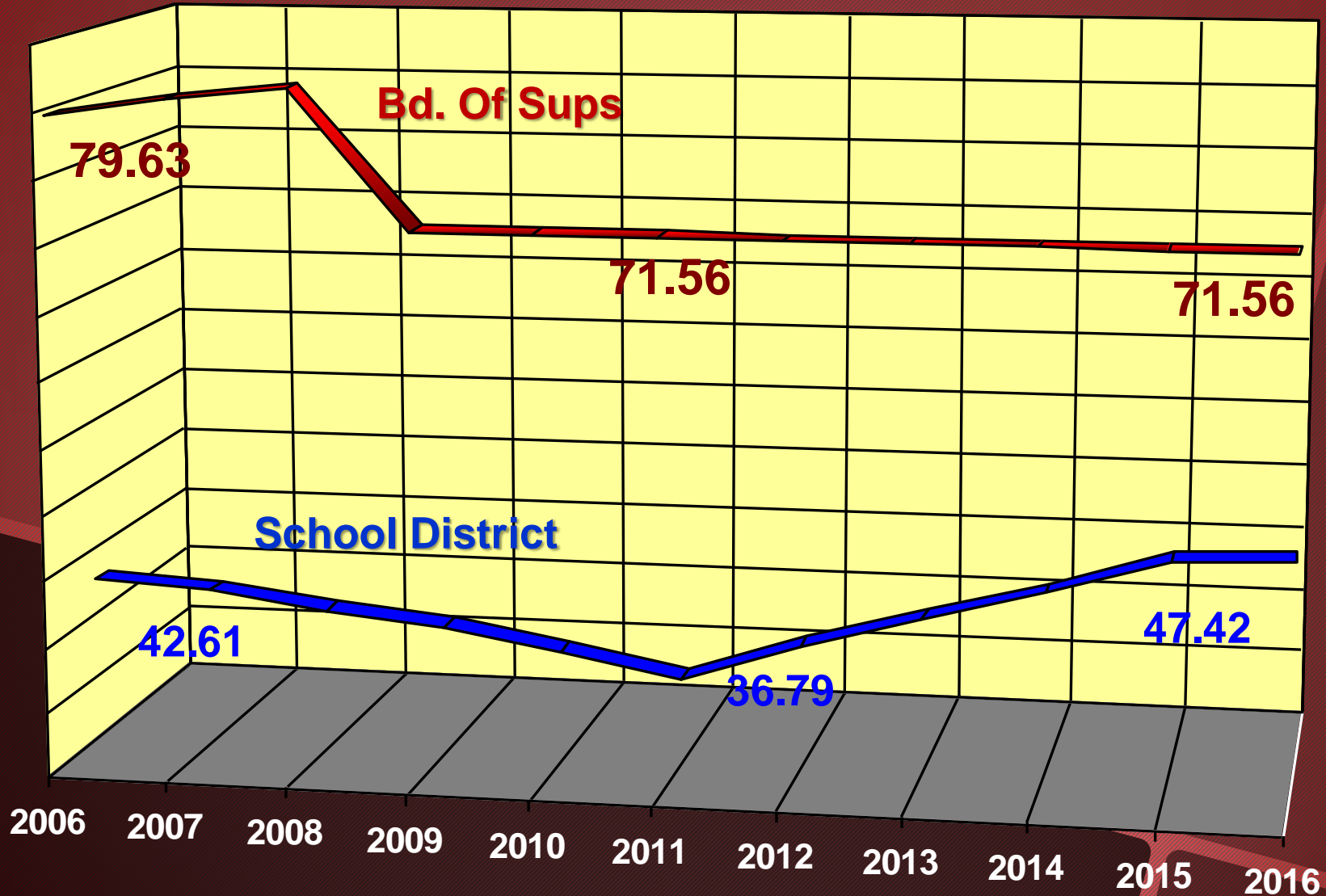

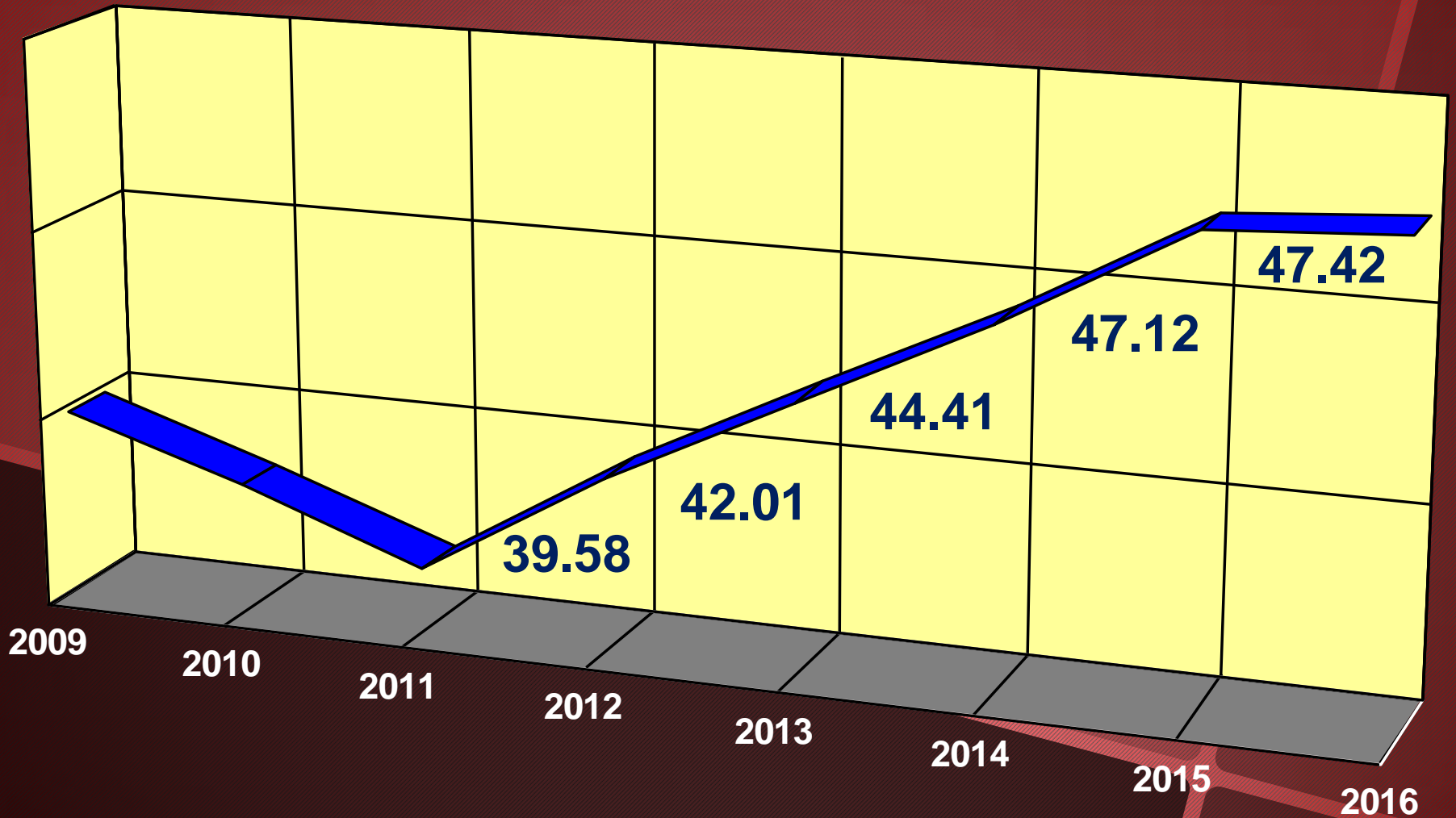

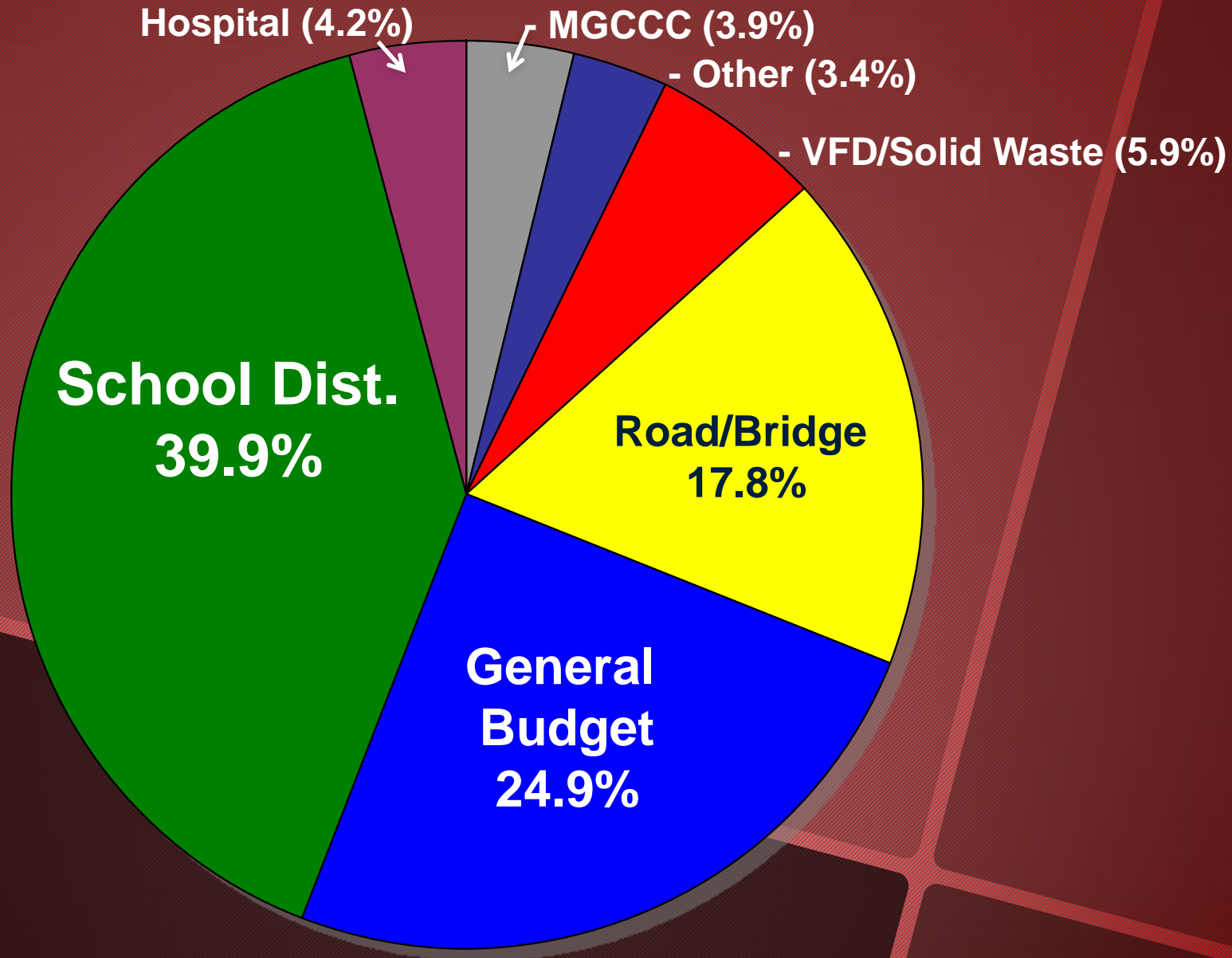


School District Millage
