

## GC launches new website for easy access to County government

A digital "ribbon cutting" officially launched the George County Board of Supervisors' new website on Monday, March 3. The site located at <a href="https://www.georgecountyms.com">www.georgecountyms.com</a> offers easy and efficient access to information on County government.

"In many ways, this website is a virtual courthouse," Board President Kelly Wright explained. "We designed it to be more than just the Supervisors' website. The site touches on all aspects of county operations."



This county-wide focus starts on the website's home page which features dropdown menus for County Officials, County Courts, and County Departments.

"We worked with elected officials and departments to develop their pages and will be able to easily update pages as the site develops," Ken Flanagan, George County Community Development Director said.

Promotion of the County's Industrial Park is another vital element on the home page. The site includes the most comprehensive online inventory and detailed descriptions of George County's Industrial Park and local large-scale commercial properties.

"For the first time online we can showcase prime industrial and commercial properties throughout the county. These pages detail access to transportation, utility infrastructure, and promote our business partnerships," Flanagan, said.



All the "online must haves" are on the County's website including a search engine, news releases, a community calendar, and a county-wide photo gallery. The "virtual courthouse" is made up of 38 pages and more than 170 photos.

"This website is part of the Board of Supervisors ongoing efforts to enhance and provide more quality information to our residents and visitors. I see this site becoming the first stop for County information," Wright said.
