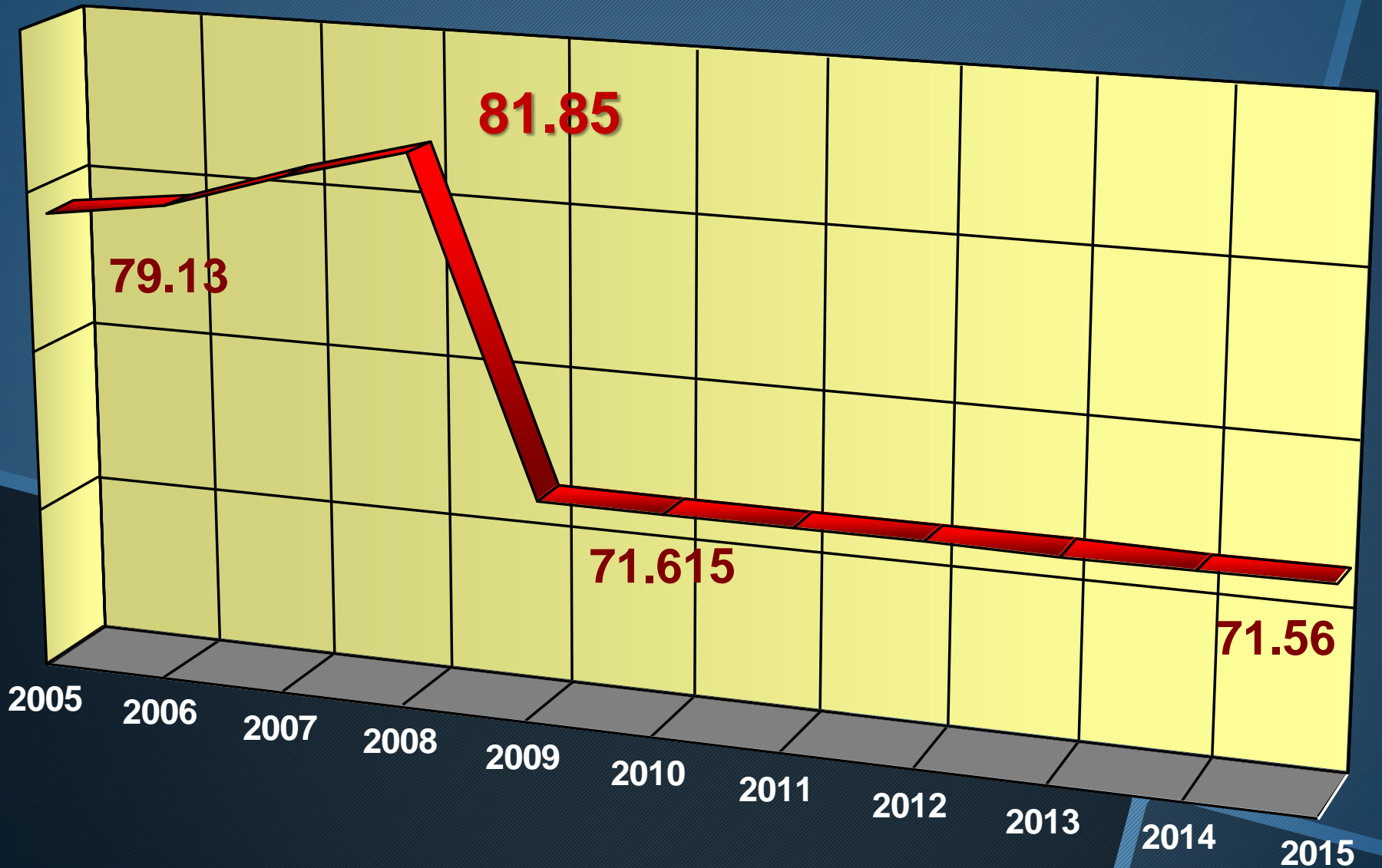

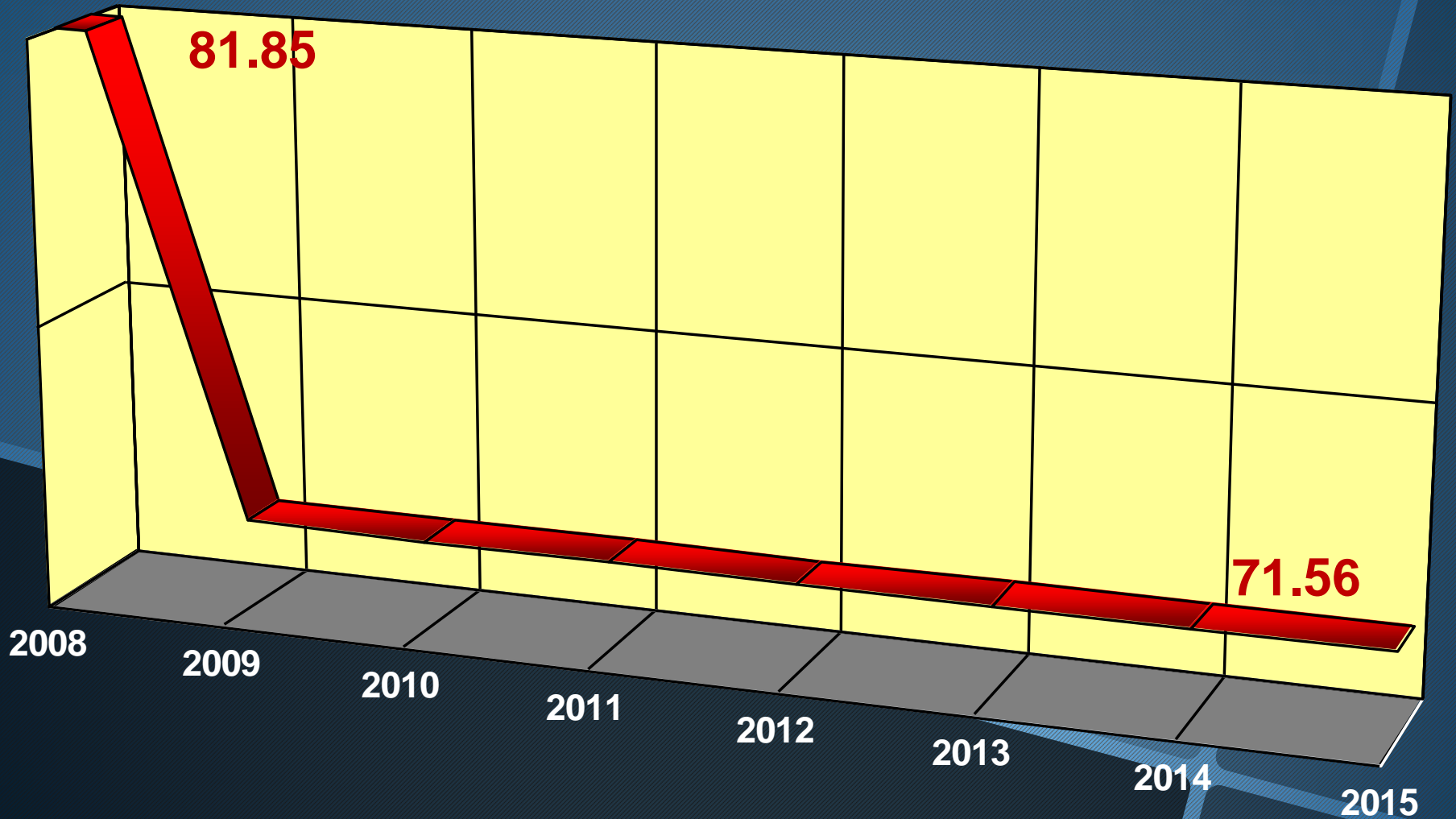
Board Millage

Zoom in view (2008-2015)

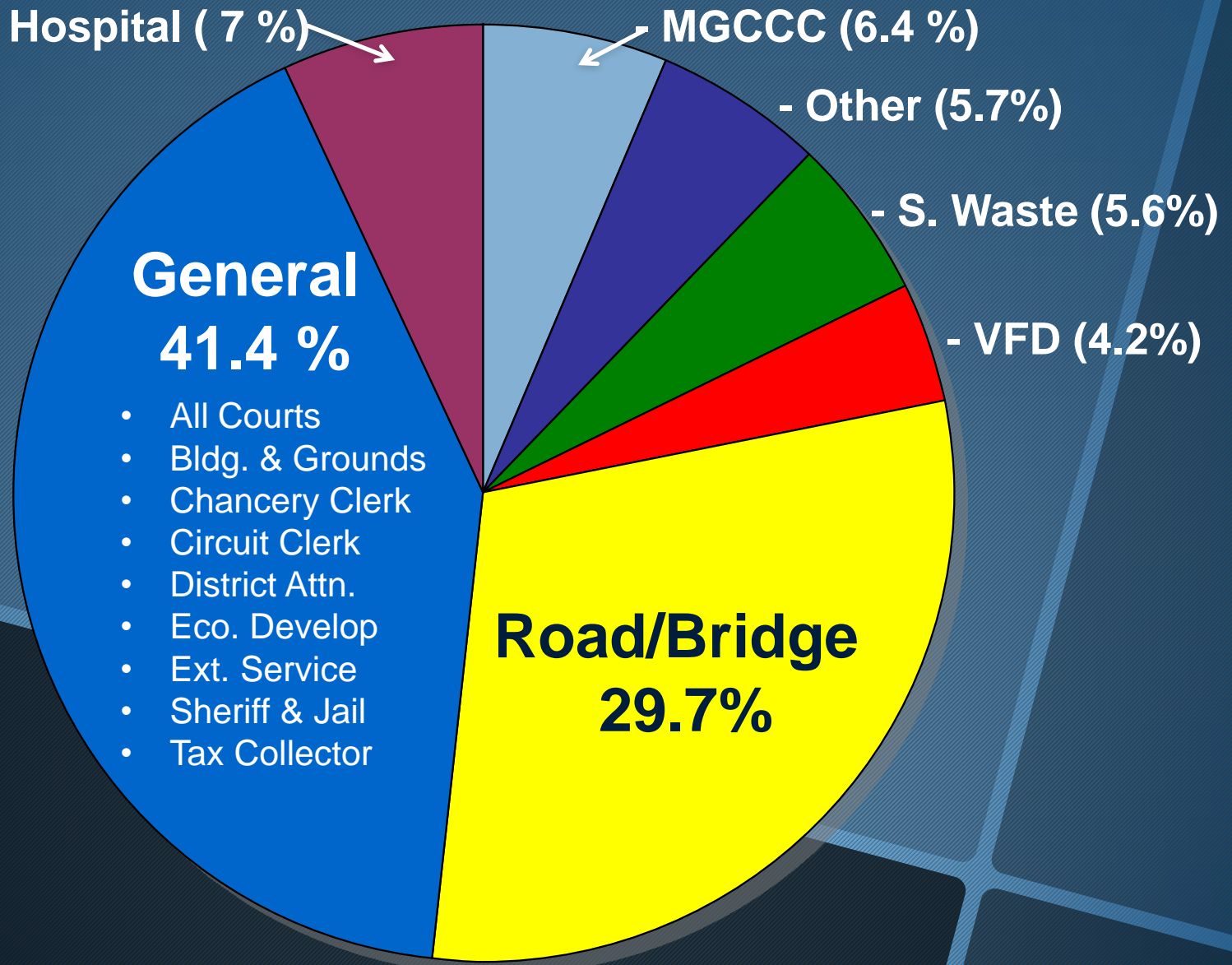


No GC Board tax increase since 2008.

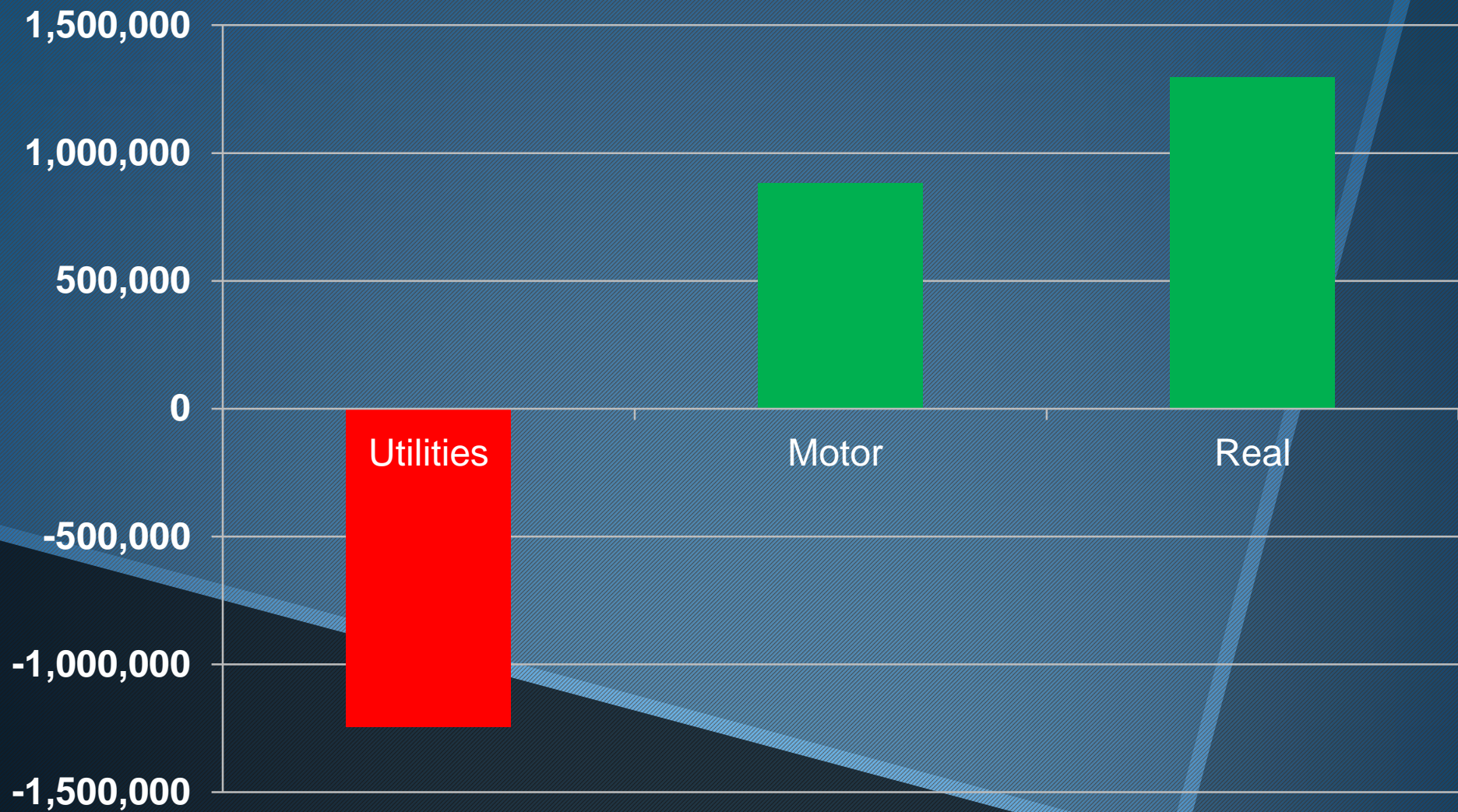

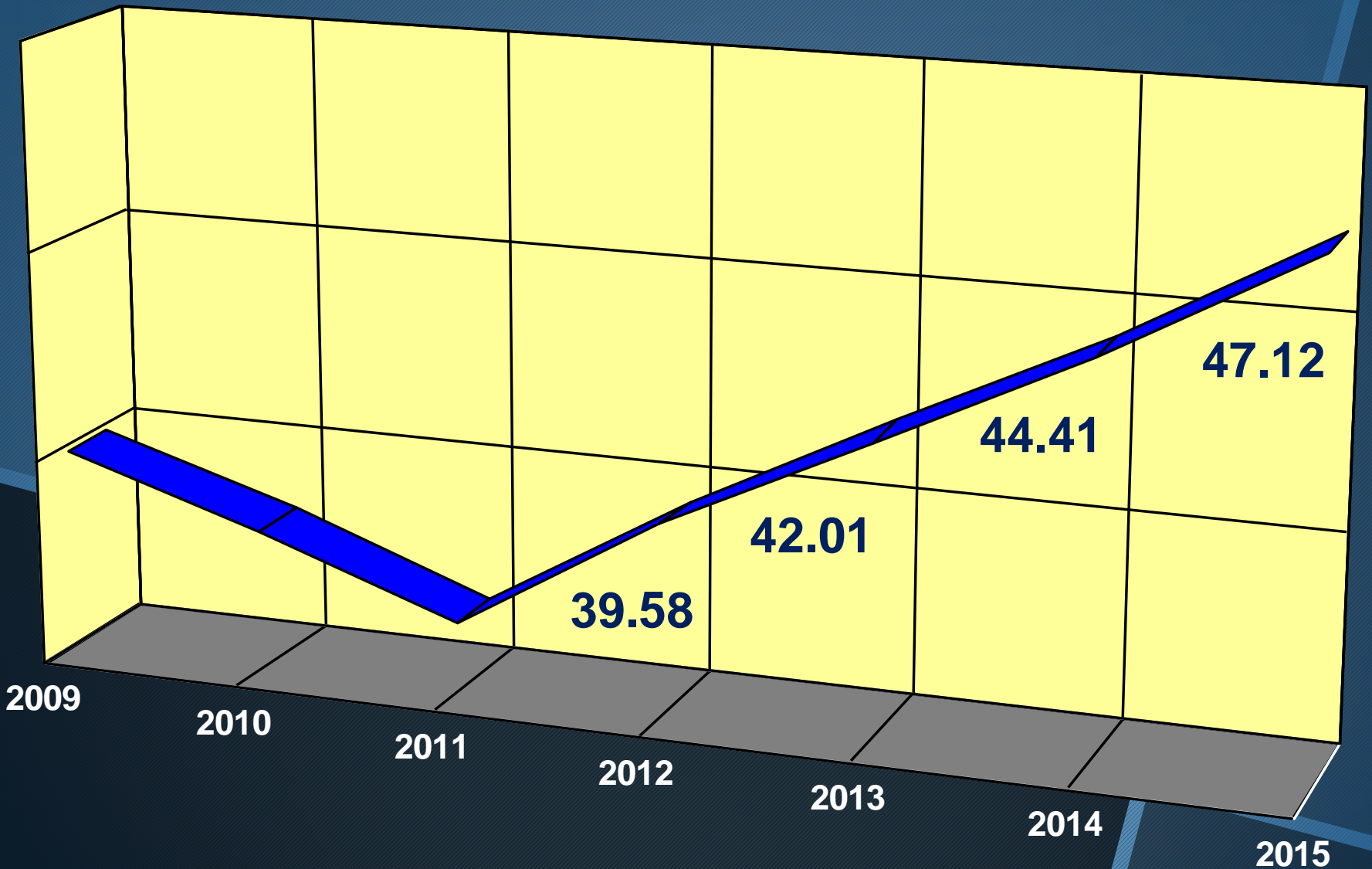
118.68 Millage Breakdown

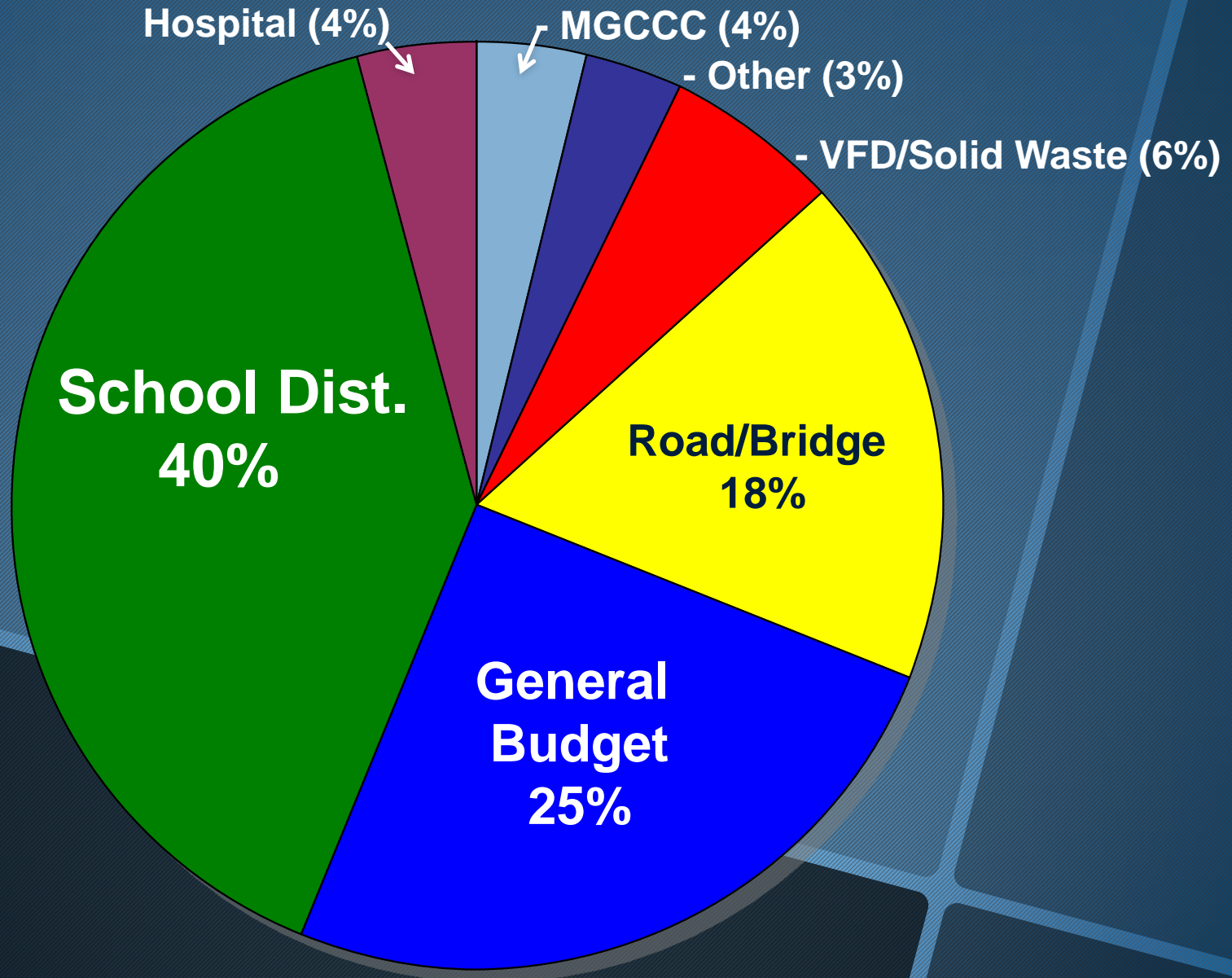


School Millage
