GC announces temporary closure on Vestry Road starting Dec. 20

Release date: Dec. 17, 2021

George County will temporarily close a section of Vestry Road to all traffic starting on Monday, December 20 for the replacement of two large drainage culverts just east of Lige Branch Creek.

The replacements will require the roadway's asphalt to be broken out and the culverts completely dug out by construction crews. There will be no traffic allowed through the temporary construction area. This project is expected to take two weeks to complete, weather permitting.

"I know this is an inconvenience for local drivers and those crossing into Stone and Jackson counties for work," District 5 Supervisor Henry Cochran explained. "But this is one of those maintenance projects that just must be done for long term safety. It should only take a few days, if the weather cooperates."

During the short-term road construction, drivers can detour using a combination of MS Highway 15 and Broome School Road. All drivers should pay special attention to new road safety signage and are asked to use caution around the construction site for road workers and heavy equipment.
