In response to Governor Tate Reeves, the George County School District has made preparations to provide free meals to children 0 to 18 years of age. This service will begin on Wednesday, March 18, 2020. The meals will consist of a bag lunch and one snack item. Parents who wish to participate should call 601-947-4318 between 8:00 and 10:00 AM each day requesting a meal. Parents should be prepared to pick up meals at George County Middle School between 11:00 AM and 12:00 PM. Please have your children present when picking up meals. It will be a drive through service/grab and go. Parents will have no need to exit vehicle. There will be no adult purchases offered. Meals **will not be served** during Spring Break, March 23<sup>rd</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup>. Meals **will not be served** on Saturday and Sunday. Another announcement will be made concerning the continuation of the service after Spring Break.

Also, due to the school closure, we are postponing the opening of Online Student Registration. We will inform parents when we open Online Student Registration for 2020-2021 school year.
