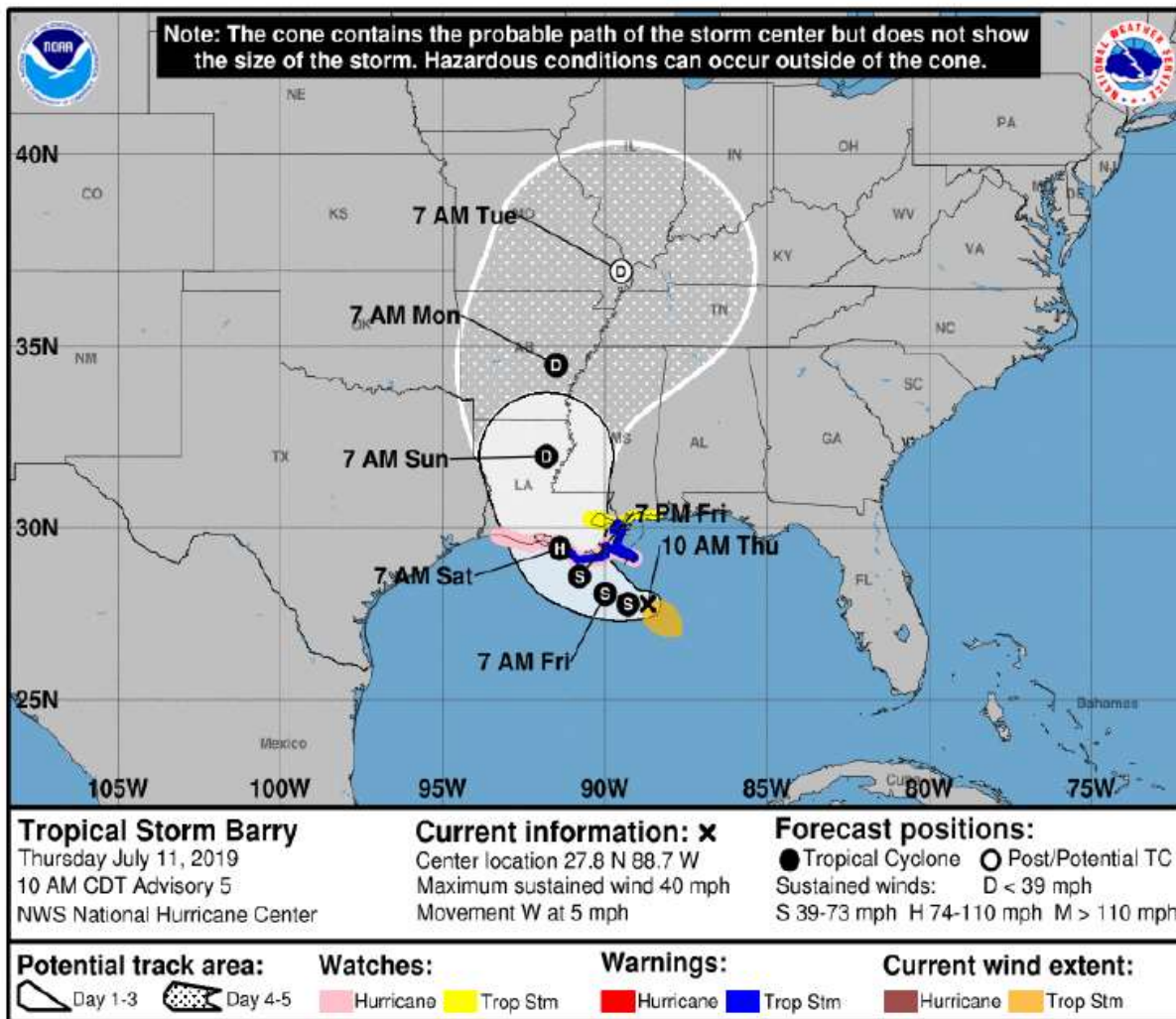

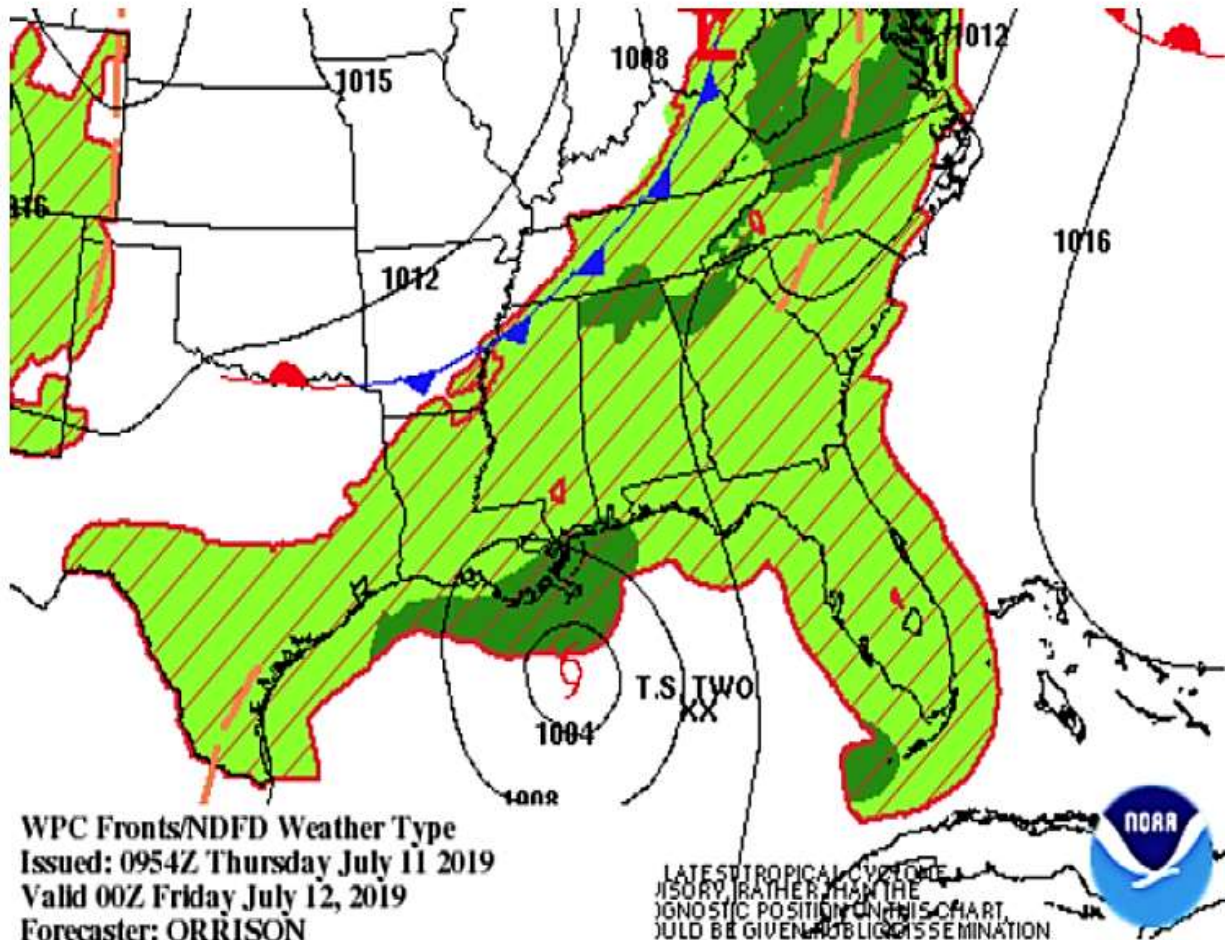
- Now Tropical Storm Barry (struggling but developing nonetheless).

- Still forecast to become a minimal hurricane.
- **Tropical Storm Watch** now east to MSAL Border.

7 PM Thursday



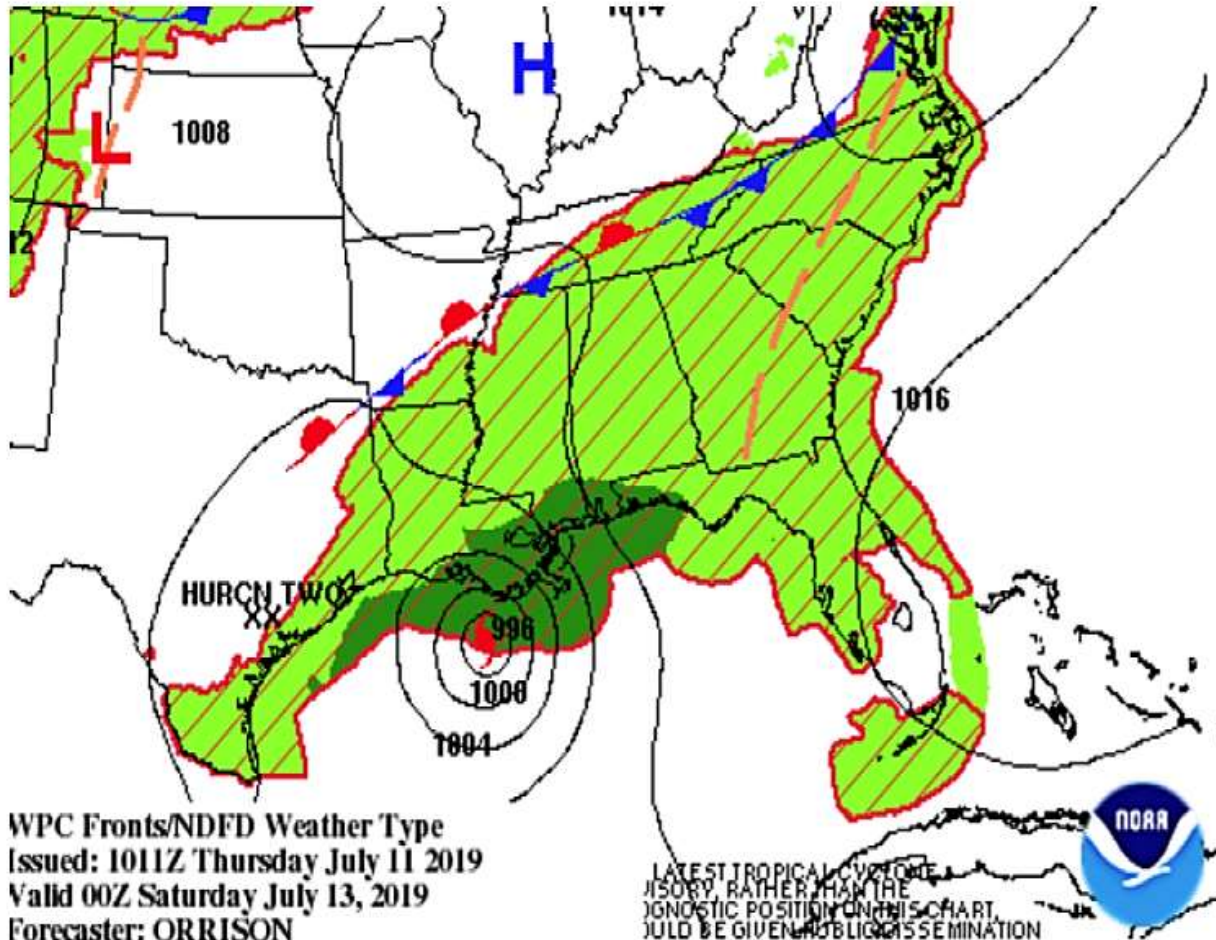
- Rip currents in progress.
- Surf heights becoming 5 to 8 feet late. Already up to 5 feet.
- Winds continue increasing over the offshore waters.
- Small Craft Conditions with gusts to Tropical Storm force possible.
- Locally heavy rainfall continues developing, especially west of Pensacola and south of Highway 84.

Evolution and Impacts



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7 PM Friday

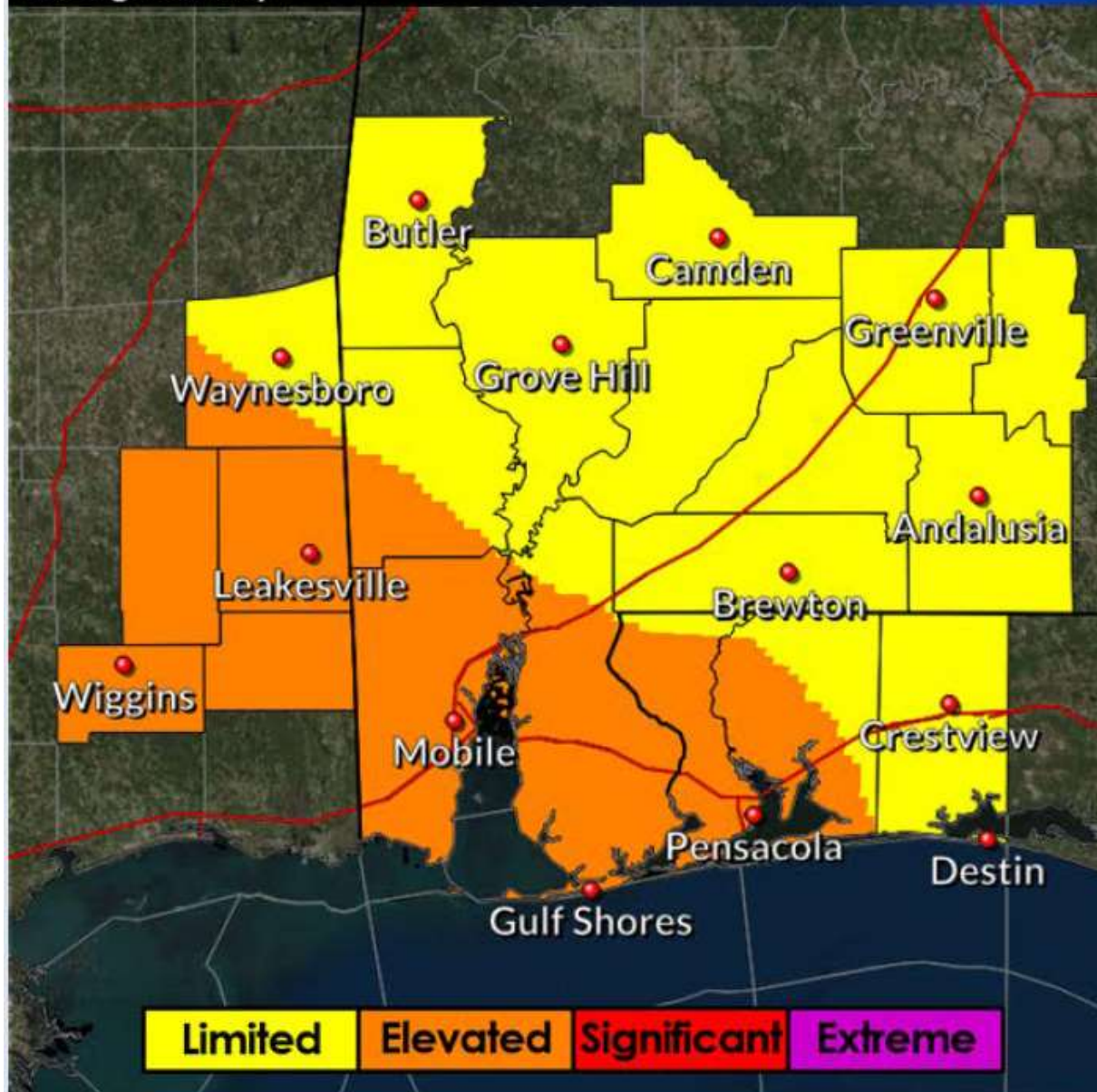


- Coastal water rises continue Friday and Saturday, with minor coastal flooding possible around time of high tide in the morning. Inundation up to 3 feet possible.
- Heavy rainfall and flooding potential continues Friday and Saturday.
- A few tornadic storms possible within outer rainbands.

LIMITED
Localized flash flooding possible, particularly of low lying and urban areas.
Minor river flooding possible.

ELEVATED
Areas of flash flooding possible. Some roads flooded or possibly closed. Some structures potentially threatened.
