The George County Board of Supervisors have announced two temporary road closures for this week.

The first is Beaver Dam Road. It will be closed from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. beginning Tuesday, June 14, and continuing through Thursday, June 16. The closures will allow Canadian National Railroad construction crews time to finish the final repairs to the railroad tracks, and for the county to overlay asphalt at the crossing.

This should conclude a project that has been under way since early in January.

The second closure will be Twin Creek Road. This road will be closed beginning Tuesday, June 14, and continuing through Thursday, June 16. This is part of the project to widen Scott Road, install curbs and gutters and resurface. Included in this project is a rerouting of Twin Creek which will soon connect Scott Road near the Catholic Church instead of Hwy. 26.

This project, which began last fall is now nearing its final phases.

The Board of Supervisors apologize for any inconvenience these temporary closures may cause.
